STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUND MED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Cape Elizabeth Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows

SECTION 1. Moses G. Palmer, Lewis Pierce, Jr., 2 Charles E. Jose, Charles B. Merrill, L. D. M. 3 Swett and John E. Palmer of Portland, and John 4 M. Robbins of Lewiston, their successors and 5 assigns, are hereby constituted a corporation by 6 the name of Cape Elizabeth Railroad Company, 7 with authority to construct, maintain and use a 8 railroad to be operated by horse or steam power, 9 for the transportation of freight and passengers, 10 from a point at or near Ferry Village in Cape 11 Elizabeth, thence along the coast as near as prac-

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12 ticable to some point in the vicinity of Prout's 13 Neck, or Libby's Neck, with all the rights and 14 privileges, and subject to all the duties and liabili-15 ties of the laws of the state.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said corporation 2 shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars, to 3 be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, 4 and no share shall be issued for less than its par 5 value.

SECT. 3. Said corporation shall have power to 2 purchase and hold such real estate as may be 3 necessary or convenient for the purpose of said 4 railroad.

SECT. 4. Said corporation, or their directors, 2 may from time to time determine what parts of 3 their railroad they desire to operate, and at what 4 portions of the year they desire to operate the 5 same; and shall not be holden to operate any part 6 thereof, or at any portion of the year, except as 7 they may determine as aforesaid.

SECT. 5. Said corporation is hereby authorized 2 to issue bonds for the purpose of constructing its 3 railroad, or for money which it may borrow for 4 purposes sanctioned by law; but the bonds so 5 issued shall not exceed the amount of capital stock 6 paid in by the stockholders. Said bonds shall be 7 issued in sums not less than one hundred 'dollars
8 each, payable in not more than twenty years from
9 their date, with interest payable semi-annually.

SECT. 6. This act shall be void unless the same 2 shall be accepted by said corporation, and ten per 3 cent. of the capital stock paid within three years 4 from the date of its approval.

SECT. 7. Nothing in this act shall deprive the 2 legislature of the right to amend, alter or repeal 3 said charter, or render said company independent 4 of the general legislative power of the state.

SECT. 8. If this railroad shall not be completed 2 on or before the first day of January, A. D. 1885.

SECT. 9. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
