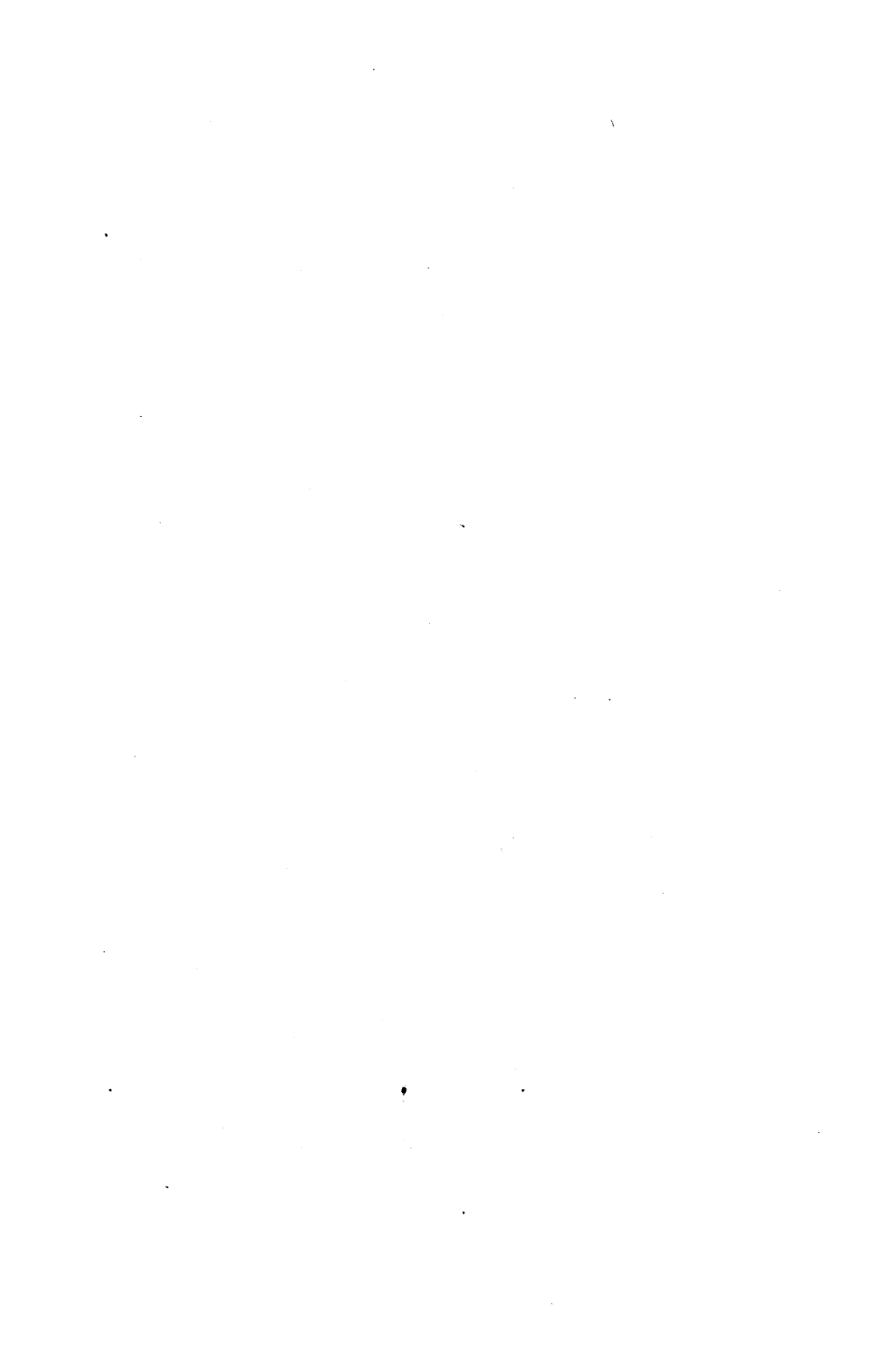
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional relating to the insolvent laws of
Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The judge of any court of insolvency shall have
2 the same power to compel the attendance, and take
3 the examination of witnesses residing in his county,
4 on application made to him by any person inter-
5 ested, as the judge of the court of insolvency in
6 the county where the proceedings are pending;
7 and such witnesses shall attend and testify in rela-
8 tion to the insolvent estate and the dealings of the
9 insolvent, and the testimony shall be reduced to
10 writing and filed in the court of insolvency where
11 the proceedings in insolvency are pending.
