STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional relating to the insolvent laws of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The judge of any court of insolvency shall have

- 2 the same power to compel the attendance, and take
- 3 the examination of witnesses residing in his county,
- 4 on application made to him by any person inter-
- 5 ested, as the judge of the court of insolvency in
- 6 the county where the proceedings are pending;
- 7 and such witnesses shall attend and testify in rela-
- 8 tion to the insolvent estate and the dealings of the
- 9 insolvent, and the testimony shall be reduced to
- 10 writing and filed in the court of insolvency where
- 11 the proceedings in insolvency are pending.
