RESOLVE requesting the attorney general to prepare and obtain a deed of certain settlers' lots of land from the treasurer of the commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Resolved, That the attoney general of this state

- 2 be directed to make and obtain a deed from the
- 3 treasurer of the commonwealth of Massachusetts,
- 4 in conformity to the following resolve:
- 5 Resolved, That the treasurer of the common-
- 6 wealth be and hereby is authorized and directed to
- 7 convey by deed to Samuel A. Holbrook, treasurer
- 8 of the State of Maine, for the use of said state, all
- 9 the right, title and interest of the commonwealth
- 10 to the "settlers" lots so called, situated in town-
- 11 ship numbered seventeen, in range seven in the
- 12 county of Aroostook, in the State of Maine;—the

13 State of Maine to make conveyances of said lots to 14 the settlers, in the same manner that the common-15 wealth would have done if no conveyances had 16 been made. Approved April 23, 1880.
