STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to bridge over East River.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Brooklyn and New 2 York are erecting a bridge over East River, con-3 necting the two cities; and whereas, the height of 4 said bridge is not in conformity with the provision 5 of its charter, rendering it necessary for all ships 6 and largest class schooners to send down their top-7 masts, causing expense and delay, and thereby in 8 winter season endangering the safety of the ves-9 sels which are compelled to pass under this bridge, 10 therefore,

Resolved, That we respectfully urge upon our 2 senators and representatives in congress to procure 3 such legislation as in their judgment will best 4 subserve the interest of navigation.

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be for-2 warded by the secretary of state to each member of 3 our delegation in congress.
