## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section sixty-seven, chapter four of the revised statutes, relating to punishment for bribery and corruption at elections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section sixty-seven, chapter four of the revised

- 2 statutes, shall be amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "chapter," in the sixth line, the words "or if
- 4 any person shall receive or offer to receive a bribe
- 5 for his vote as aforesaid," so that said section as
- 6 amended shall read as follows:
- 7 If any person by bribery, menace or willful false-
- 8 hood, or other corrupt means, directly or indirectly
- 9 attempts to influence any voter of this state in
- 10 giving his vote or ballot, or to induce him to with-

11 hold it, or disturbs or hinders him in the full exer12 cise of his right of suffrage, at any election held
13 under the provisions of the constitution, or of this
14 chapter, or if any person shall receive or offer to
15 receive a bribe for his vote as aforesaid, he shall be
16 fined not more than five hundred dollars or impris17 oned not less than one year, and be ineligible to

18 any office in this state for ten years.
