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Amendment to Section 7, Senate Document No. 4.

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Strike out the words "full medical" in the eighth  
2 line; also, strike out all between the words "study"  
3 in the ninth line and "and" in the tenth line of  
4 section seven. Insert instead thereof the words  
5 "of three years under the direction of a practi-  
6 tioner of medicine who, a graduate of an incorpo-  
7 rated medical college, shall have attended two full  
8 courses of medical lectures in some incorporated  
9 medical college, the last of which, previous to  
10 graduation, shall have been in this institution;  
11 shall deposit with the faculty satisfactory certifi-  
12 cates of good moral character, and shall pass satis-  
13 factory public examination in anatomy, physiol-  
14 ogy, surgery, chemistry and obstetrics," so that  
15 said section as amended shall read as follows:

16 *Sect. 7.* The teachers and professors employed  
17 as herein specified, shall have power to confer

18 degrees and grant public testimonials to students  
19 who satisfactorily complete any one or more of the  
20 prescribed courses of study. *Provided, however,*  
21 that no diploma or medical degree for the practice  
22 of medicine shall be granted, excepting to students  
23 who shall have completed a course of study of  
24 three years under the direction of a practitioner of  
25 medicine who, a graduate of an incorporated med-  
26 ical college, shall have attended two full courses  
27 of medical lectures in some incorporated medical  
28 college, the last of which, previous to graduation,  
29 shall have been in this institution; shall deposit  
30 with the faculty satisfactory certificates of good  
31 moral character, and shall pass satisfactory public  
32 examination in anatomy, physiology, surgery,  
33 chemistry and obstetrics. And this act shall take  
34 effect from its approval by the governor.
