RESOLVE in aid of building a bridge over Fish river in Eagle Lake plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars.

- 2 be and the same is hereby appropriated in aid of
- 3 building a bridge over Fish River in Eagle Lake
- 4 plantation, to be expended under the direction of
- 5 the county commissioners of Aroostook county;
- 6 provided, that a bridge over said river is built to-
- 7 the satisfaction of said commissioners.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The undersigned beg leave respectfully to represent, that the State road from Ashland to Fort Kent, in the county of Aroostook, is very much out of repair, and will require quite an outlay of money to put the same in proper condition for public travel and the safe transportation of the mails. But the matter to which we desire more especially to call the attention of the Legislature, is the dangerous condition of the bridge on this road, across Fish river, in Township No. 16, Range 7, Eagle Lake plantation, which must be rebuilt the coming season, and would, in our opinion, be unreasonably burdensome upon the inhabitants and owners of said township to rebuild, in addition to their assessments for repair of the road. We therefore recommend that an appropriation of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) be made by the State in aid of rebuilding said bridge.
