STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of an appropriation on roads, including bridge in Indian township, in the county of Washington.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty 2 dollars be, and is hereby appropriated yearly for 3 the years eighteen hundred and eighty-one and 4 eighty-two, on the Houlton and Baring road across 5 the Indian township, in the county of Washington. 6 Also two hundred dollars for each of said years, 7 to be expended on the road leading from said 8 Houlton and Baring road, in said township, to the 9 Grand Lake stream. Also one hundred dollars 10 to be expended the coming year on the bridge 11 across said Grand Lake stream, all of which is to 12 be expended by the county commissioners of Wash- 13 ington county.
