STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of the construction of a road
between the town of Brownville and the Katahdin
iron works.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars
2 be appropriated in aid of the construction of a
3 road between the town of Brownville, in the
4 county of Penobscot, and the Katahdin iron works
5 in said county, to be expended under the direction
6 of the county commissioners of said county; *pro-*
7 *vided, however*, that said sum shall not be paid
8 until a certificate signed by said county commis-
9 sioners stating that said road has been built to
10 their satisfaction, has been filed with the state
11 treasurer; *and provided further*, that the town of
12 Williamsburg shall not be liable for any portion of
13 the expenses of building or repairing said road,

14 nor for any damages to any person or his prop-
15 erty caused by a defect in said road after the same
16 is built.
