STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Harpswell to lay out a town way, and build a bridge from Bailey's island to Orr's island, in said town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of Harpswell, in the
2 county of Cumberland, are hereby authorized to
3 locate a town way, and build a bridge from Bailey's
4 island across Willis' straits to Orr's island in said
5 town on petition therefor, in the same manner and
6 by the same proceedings throughout, and with the
7 same rights of appeal as are provided in chapter
8 eighteen of the revised statutes concerning town
9 and private ways on the land; but such road and

10 bridge are to be so constructed as not to injure
11 navigation, and to make suitable draw or draws
12 therein for that purpose if necessary.
