STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to abolish continuance fees in certain supreme judicial and superior courts of the state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All fees for the continuance of 2 causes in the supreme judicial and superior courts 3 of the state in which the clerks are salaried officers, 4 are hereby abolished.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this, are hereby repealed.
