## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT entitled an act to permit the Bridgton and Presumpscot River Railroad Company to sell or lease its road.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Bridgton and Presumpscot

- 2 River Railroad Company, when organized, is
- 3 hereby authorized and empowered to sell or lease
- 4 its line, either before or after completion, and all its
- 5 improvements to any person or persons, or any
- 6 other railroad corporation, which person or persons
- 7 or which latter corporation is hereby authorized to
- 8 enter into such contract of sale or lease, and the
- 9 directors of the two corporations may enter into
- 10 such contract for the running of the road, and for

- 11 the purchase, sale or lease thereof, as the directors 12 of the two companies in the exercise of their best 13 judgment and discretion, may deem for the ad-14 vantage of their respective corporations, subject 15 to the approval of the stockholders in each corpor-16 ation.
- SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
