STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the county commissioners of York county to locate and establish a highway across Spinney's creek.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Authority is hereby granted to the

- 2 county commissioners of York county to locate
- 3 and establish a highway over the tide waters of
- 4 Spinney's creek (so-called), leading from So. Eliot
- 5 to Kittery, in said county, by the same proceedings
- 6 and in the same manner as would be required to
- 7 lay out and establish such highway if said waters
- 8 were not tide waters: provided, however, that in
- 9 any bridge over said river, there shall be con-

- 10 structed and maintained a good and sufficient draw
- 11 therein, so that navigation shall not be obstructed.

 Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
