STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter six, section ten of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives: in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter six, section ten of the revised statutes, is 2 hereby amended by inserting the word "bark" after 3 the word "wood," in the second and fourth lines of 4 said section, so that said section as amended shall 5 read as follows:

6 Whenever the owner of real estate, notifies the 7 assessors that any part of the wood, bark and tim-8 ber standing thereon, has been sold by contract in 9 writing, and exhibits to them proper evidence 10 thereof, they shall assess such wood, bark and tim-11 ber to the purchaser thereof.
