AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of  
government.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In order to provide for the several  
2 acts and resolves of the legislature, requiring the  
3 payment of money from the treasury, and also to  
4 provide for the necessary expenditures of govern-  
5 ment for the current fiscal year of eighteen hundred  
6 eighty-one, the following sums are hereby appro-  
7 priated out of any moneys in the treasury, and the  
8 governor, with the advice and consent of the  
9 council, is authorized at any time prior to the first  
10 day of January next to draw his warrant on the  
11 treasury for the same:
