STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to prevent railroad accidents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Any person, other than a servant or employe of the
2 road or a passenger holding a ticket, for a passage
3 over the road, who shall get upon or leave any
4 steam engine, tender or car at any place outside of
5 a railroad station, whilst such engine, tender or
6 car is in motion, shall be punished by imprison-
7 ment not exceeding thirty days or by a fine not
8 exceeding ten dollars. The provisions of this act
9 shall not affect the liability of any railroad corpor-
10 ation for injuries or damage caused by the fault or
11 negligence of the corporation or its servants.
