STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to enable the state superintendent of common schools to hold teachers' meetings, as provided in item four of section seventy-one, chapter eleven of the revised statutes.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars

- 2 be and the same is hereby appropriated for the year
- 3 eighteen hundred and eighty-one, and the like sum
- 4 for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, the
- 5 same to be taken from any school money belonging
- 6 to the state, to enable the state superintendent of
- 7 common schools to defray the expenses of holding
- 8 teachers' meetings in the several counties of this
- 9 state; which sums shall be expended under the
- 10 direction of the state superintendent, all bills for
- 11 which shall be audited by the governor and coun-
- 12 cil; provided, however, that no bills shall be paid

13 from said sums except for advertising such meet-14 ings, and paying actual travelling expenses of 15 speakers and lecturers not residing in the counties 16 in which such meetings are held.
