STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to enable the state superintendent of common schools to hold teachers' meetings, as provided in item four of section seventy-one, chapter eleven of the revised statutes.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars
2 be and the same is hereby appropriated for the year
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-one, and the like sum
4 for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, the
5 same to be taken from any school money belonging
6 to the state, to enable the state superintendent of
7 common schools to defray the expenses of holding
8 teachers' meetings in the several counties of this
9 state; which sums shall be expended under the
10 direction of the state superintendent, all bills for
11 which shall be audited by the governor and coun-
12 cil; *provided, however,* that no bills shall be paid

13 from said sums except for advertising such meet-
14 ings, and paying actual travelling expenses of
15 speakers and lecturers not residing in the counties
16 in which such meetings are held.
