

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to the recording of certain papers and records now in the land office.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized and

- 2 instructed to cause to be recorded in volumes suit-
- 3 able for said purpose, the copies of deeds of lands
- 4 in this state now on file in the land office, which
- 5 have been received from the Commonwealth of
- 6 Massachusetts, together with the maps, plans of
- 7 survey, field notes, certificates, and other evidences
- 8 of title and limits, relating to said lands; provided,
- 9 that the total expense for the same shall not ex-
- 10 ceed the sum of three hundred dollars.
