## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section five of the public laws of 1876, relating to the taxation of insurance companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter one hundred 2 and twenty-nine of the public laws of eighteen 3 hundred and seventy-six, shall be and is hereby 4 amended, so that said section shall read as follows: 5 Every insurance company or association incor-6 porated by or organized under the laws of any 7 other state, or if incorporated or organized under 8 the laws of a foreign country, having its principal 9 office in any other state, and admitted to transact 10 business in this state, shall pay the same fees and 11 taxes upon business done in this state, as are im-

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12 posed by such other state upon any similar insur-13 ance companies incorporated by or organized 14 under the laws of this state; and if any company 15 refuses or unreasonably neglects to pay such fees 16 and taxes upon proper demand, the insurance com-17 missioner shall suspend the right of said company 18 to do business in this state.

SECT. 2. Any former act or acts, repugnant to 2 this act, are hereby repealed, except that the tax 3 for eighteen hundred and eighty, shall be assessed 4 and collected under the provisions of the acts then 5 in force.
