STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the years eighteen hundred eighty-one and eighteen hundred eighty-two.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treas-2 ury, to be expended under the direction of the 3 governor and council, to the agent of the Passa-4 maquoddy tribe of Indians for the benefit of said 5 tribe, for the years eighteen hundred eighty-one 6 and eighteen hundred eighty-two, as follows: For 7 May dividends, four hundred dollars each year; 8 for November dividends, three hundred dollars 9 each year; for distressed poor, two thousand dol-10 lars each year; for agricultural purposes, six hun-11 dred dollars each year; for bounty on crops, three 12 hundred dollars each year; for plowing, one hun-13 dred and fifty dollars each year; for salaries of 14 governors, one hundred dollars each year; for

15 salaries of lieutenant governors, forty dollars each 16 year; for wood, two hundred dollars each year; 17 for contingent expenses, one hundred dollars each 18 year; for educational purposes, six hundred dollars 19 each year, to be expended under the supervision of 20 the agent of said tribe and the resident priest; for 21 salary of priest, one hundred dollars each year; for 22 dressing for land, one hundred dollars each year; 23 for salary of agent, three hundred dollars each 24 year; for contingent poor fund, four hundred dol-25 lars each year.
