STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section six of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, relating to the salary of the agent of the Passamaquoddy Indians.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section six of chapter one hundred and twenty-
2 five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
3 seventy-nine, is hereby amended by striking out
4 the word "two," in the second line of said section,
5 and inserting the word "three," so that said section
6 as amended shall read as follows :

7 *Sect. 6.* Agent of Penobscot tribe of Indians,
8 two hundred dollars per annum; agent of Passa-
9 maquoddy Indians, three hundred dollars per year.
