STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes, relating to auctions and auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one, of chapter thirty-four,
- 2 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter
- 3 twenty-eight of the public laws of eighteen hun-
- 4 dred and seventy-eight, is hereby amended by
- 5 striking out the words "voter of their town," in
- 6 the second line thereof, and inserting instead there-
- 7 of the words "voters thereof;" and also by strik-
- 8 ing out all of the third line thereof, after the word
- 9 "year" in said line, and also by striking out all of
- 10 said section after the word "licensed" in the fifth
- 11 line thereof, and by adding after said word
- 12 "licensed," the words "shall pay to the treasurer

- 13 of said town the sum of five dollars for the use of 14 said town, and shall be authorized to sell as 15 auctioneers in said town, and in all other towns in 16 the same county," so that said section as amended
- 17 shall read as follows:

26 towns in the same county.

- 18 Sect. 1. The municipal officers of any town 19 may license any legal voters thereof by a writing 20 under their hands to be auctioneers for one year, 21 and shall record every such license in a book kept 22 for that purpose. Persons so licensed shall pay to 23 the treasurer of said town the sum of five dollars 24 for the use of said town, and shall be authorized 25 to sell as auctioneers in said town, and in all other
 - SECT. 2. Section three of said chapter thirty-2 four, is hereby amended by striking out all after 3 the word "sold," in the third line, and before the 4 word "and," in the eighth line, so that said section 5 as amended shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 3. Every person licensed shall keep a 7 fair and particular account of all goods and chat-8 tels by him sold, stating of whom received and the 9 price for which the same were sold, and in default 10 thereof he shall be liable to a fine of not less than 11 fifty, nor more than three hundred dollars.
