STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of fish in the Kenne-
bec river and its tributaries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No person shall be allowed during
2 the month of December, and from the first to the
3 twentieth day of January of each year, to take
4 fish by the use of nets or seines from the Kenne-
5 bec river and its tributaries, so far up said river and
6 its tributaries as tide waters extend.

SECT. 2. If any person shall take fish from said
2 Kennebec river and its tributaries, in violation of
3 this act, he shall forfeit and pay a penalty of fifty
4 dollars (\$50.00) for each offense; one-half to the

5 use of the state, and the other half to the use of
6 the person prosecuting therefor.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
