STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT for the prevention of hunting matches.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Leyislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall be allowed to en-2 gage in hunting matches for the killing and 3 destruction of game in this state.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall wilfully violate 2 the provisions of section one of this act, shall be 3 punished by a fine of ten dollars, to be recovered 4 upon complaint before any municipal court or 5 trial justice. . . .
