IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT permitting female citizens to vote in school matters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Female citizens of this state possess-2 ing the other constitutional and statutory qualifi-3 cations for electors, are entitled to vote in the 4 choice of school officers in town meetings and 5 ward meetings, and upon all questions in school 6 district meetings.

SECT. 2. The provisions of law relative to the 2 listing and registration of voters, shall apply to 3 female citizens entitled to vote under the above 4 section.
