IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the criminal jurisdiction of the superior court for the county of Kennebec.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The jurisdiction in all criminal matters conferred upon the superior court, within and for the county of Kennebec, by the provisions of chapter ten of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, is hereby restored, and said superior court, on and after the passage of this act, shall have and exercise jurisdiction in all criminal matters in said county of Kennebec.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
