STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and eightytwo of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, relating to auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty-

- 2 two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
- 3 eighty, is hereby amended by adding after the
- 4 word "auction," in the sixth line of section ten, the
- 5 words "in said city or town where said special
- 6 license is granted, and no where else," so that said
- 7 section as amended shall read as follows:
- 8 Sect. 10. The municipal officers of any city or
- 9 town in this state, may grant upon presentation of
- 10 an invoice or inventory of the property to be sold,
- 11 which shall be produced unless said municipal

12 officers shall decide that the same is unnecessary, 13 a special license to any auctioneer, a legal voter 14 in this state, to sell at public auction in said city 15 or town where said special license is granted, and 16 nowhere else, between the hours of seven o'clock 17 A. M. and six o'clock P. M., upon payment of 18 five dollars for each and every invoice or inven-19 tory; the above license fee to go to the use of said 20 city or town.

Sect. 2. All special licenses heretofore granted 2 under existing laws not in accordance with the 3 above section as amended, shall terminate upon 4 the passage of this act.
