IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND-EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirteen, section three, of the revised statutes, relating to practice of medicine and surgery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That section three, of chapter thirteen, of the

- 2 revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 Sect. 3. No person, except a physician or sur-
- 5 geon who commenced practice in the state of
- 6 Maine prior to the approval of this act, or has
- 7 received a medical degree at a public medical in-
- 8 stitution in the United States, or a license from the
- 9 Maine Medical Association, shall recover any com-
- 10 pensation for medical or surgical services.
