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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-ONE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter thirteen, section three,  
of the revised statutes, relating to practice of medi-  
cine and surgery.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

That section three, of chapter thirteen, of the  
2 revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read  
3 as follows:

4 *Sect. 3.* No person, except a physician or sur-  
5 geon who commenced practice in the state of  
6 Maine prior to the approval of this act, or has  
7 received a medical degree at a public medical in-  
8 stitution in the United States, or a license from the  
9 Maine Medical Association, shall recover any com-  
10 pensation for medical or surgical services.
