STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT for the navigation of Winnecook lake in
the county of Waldo.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Edgar F. Whitehouse, his associates
2 and assigns, are hereby authorized to clear chan-
3 nels, dredge bars, remove stones and build piers in
4 Winnecook lake, otherwise called Unity pond, in
5 the county of Waldo ; and they are hereby vested
6 with the exclusive right against all persons and
7 corporations, of employing and navigating every
8 kind of boat or water craft propelled by steam, for
9 carrying passengers or freight on said lake, for the
10 term of ten years from the passage of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person or corporation who shall
2 use or employ on said lake any boat or other water

3 craft propelled by steam, as carriers of passengers
4 or freight, without being authorized by said cor-
5 porator, his associates or assigns, shall forfeit for
6 each offence not less than twenty dollars, nor ex-
7 ceeding one hundred dollars, to be recovered by
8 and for the use of said corporator, his associates
9 and assigns, in an action of debt.

SECT. 3. Provided the said corporator, his asso-
2 ciates or assigns shall neglect for the term of three
3 years to navigate said lake by steam, as herein
4 provided, and provided he or they, after the com-
5 mencement of such navigation shall neglect for
6 three years at any one time to so navigate said
7 lake, then this charter shall be void.
