STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the construction and main-
tenance of a dam across the Pemaquid river.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Samuel Sylvester, his associates, suc-
2 cessors and assigns, are hereby authorized to con-
3 struct and maintain a dam high enough to exclude
4 tide waters, across the Pemaquid river in Bristol,
5 between land of James W. Partridge on the east
6 side and land of Charles P. Tibbetts on the west
7 side thereof, and with the consent of the said
8 Partridge and Tibbetts to join the said dam to the
9 shores of their said lands respectively, and by
10 means thereof to create and hold a pond of fresh
11 water within the banks of the river aforesaid, and

12 to maintain and continue the same for the purpose
13 of cutting and housing ice for market.

SECT. 2. The said Sylvester, his associates, suc-
2 cessors and assigns are hereby also authorized to
3 build and maintain in tide-waters below and near
4 said dam, joining his own land or land or lands of
5 another or others, by the lease, license or consent
6 of the owner or owners thereof, wharves, piers and
7 other structures and fixtures required and suitable
8 for housing, conveying and shipping ice from the
9 said pond.

SECT. 3. The said Sylvester, his associates, suc-
2 cessors and assigns, shall have the exclusive privi-
3 lege of cutting and removing ice from the pond so
4 to be creative as aforesaid, for sale.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
