STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the erection of an additional building to the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine Insane Hospital be, and are hereby authorized and directed to erect a suitable building for the accommodation and better classification of patients, at some point on the hospital premises; *provided,* the means for the purpose can be drawn from the accrued funds and current income of the hospital during the years eighteen hundred and eighty-one and eighteen hundred and eighty-two; said building to be completed during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two. But not more than eighty-five per cent. of such funds or income shall be used in any one year. The cost of such building shall not exceed the sum of twenty-four thousand dollars. Plans and specifications of said building shall be

16 made by the trustees, and the materials, erection
17 and completion of the building shall be done by
18 contract or contracts, and the trustees shall super-
19 intend the work as it progresses. Chapter one
20 hundred and ninety-eight of the resolves of eigh-
21 teen hundred and eighty is hereby repealed.
