STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the erection of an additional building to the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine Insane 2 Hospital be, and are hereby authorized and directed 3 to erect a suitable building for the accommodation 4 and better classifiation of patients, at some point 5 on the hospital premises; provided, the means for 6 the purpose can be drawn from the accrued funds 7 and current income of the hospital during the 8 years eighteen hundred and eighty-one and eigh-9 teen hundred and eighty-two; said building to be 10 completed during the year eighteen hundred and But not more than eighty-five per 11 eighty-two. 12 cent. of such funds or income shall be used in any 13 one year. The cost of such building shall not ex-14 ceed the sum of twenty-four thousand dollars. 15 Plans and specifications of said building shall be

- 16 made by the trustees, and the materials, erection
- 17 and completion of the building shall be done by
- 18 contract or contracts, and the trustees shall super-
- 19 intend the work as it progresses. Chapter one
- 20 hundred and ninety-eight of the resolves of eigh-
- 21 teen hundred and eighty is hereby repealed.
