STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section eight (8) of chapter nineteen (19) of the revised statutes, relating to fast driving on bridges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eight (8) of chapter nineteen (19) of the 2 revised statutes, shall be amended by inserting 3 after the word "complaint" in the second line of 4 said section, the words "made by any one of the 5 owners of said bridge, or any municipal officer of 6 the town in which said bridge is located," so that 7 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

8 Sect. 8. For a willful violation of the provis-9 ions of the preceding section a person forfeits 10 three dollars, to be recovered on complaint made 11 by any one of the owners of said bridge, or any

12 municipal officer of the town in which said bridge 13 is located, to the use of the owners of the bridge, 14 or the town required to keep it in repair, with the 15 costs of prosecution; but no person passing after 16 sunset and before sunrise is liable to such forfeit-17 ure, without proof that he previously had knowl-18 edge of such prohibition.
