STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of fish from Messabesic pond and its outlet, in the town of Alfred.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are forbidden to take

- 2 fish of any kind, in any manner, from Messabesic
- 3 pond, sometimes called Shaker pond, and its out-
- 4 let, as far down stream as the mill dam of Little-
- 5 field Brothers, in the town of Alfred, county of
- 6 York, for a term of two years from the passage of
- 7 this act.

SECT. 2. Any person who violates the provisions

- 2 of this act, shall pay the sum of five dollars for
- 3 each fish taken, to be recovered on complaint before
- 4 any trial justice in said county of York, one-half

- 5 to the use of the complainant, and the other half6 to the use of said county.
- SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
