STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to exempt the towns of Blanchard and Shirley from damages in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No action shall hereafter be maintained against

- 2 the towns of Blanchard or Shirley, in the county
- 3 of Piscataquis, by any teamster or owner of any
 - 4 team or wagon for damages occasioned to the same
 - 5 when driving teams on the road from Blanchard
 - 6 station to Greenville, drawn by more than two
- 7 horses or oxen, with wheels less than four inches in
- 8 width, and when drawn by more than four oxen or
- 9 horses, with wheels less than five inches in width.
