STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to set off Ephraim Grant and others, with
their lands, from the town of Columbia and annex
the same to the town of Cherryfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Ephraim Grant, Elisha C. Grant,
2 Elmira Grant and Samuel H. Tyler, with the lands
3 upon which they reside, being lots numbered one,
4 two, twenty-five and twenty-six, on the plan of
5 Columbia, being four lots in the south-western
6 part of said Columbia, are hereby set off from the
7 town of Columbia, in the county of Washington,
8 and annexed to the town of Cherryfield in the
9 same county.

SECT. 2. All taxes heretofore assessed upon the
2 persons or property hereby set off, may be col-
3 lected by the collector of the town of Columbia, in
4 manner as if this act had not been passed.
