## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, relating to damages for land taken for highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

If damages shall be sustained by any persons in

- 2 their property, by laying out, altering, or discon-
- 3 tinuing a highway, or town way, the commission-
- 4 ers, or municipal officers of towns shall estimate
- 5 the amount, and in their return state the share of
- 6 each separately; but they shall not order such
- 7 damages to be paid, nor shall a person claiming
- 8 damage have a right to demand the same, until the
- 9 land over which the highway or alteration is loca-
- 10 ted has been entered upon and possession taken
- 11 for the purpose of constructing or useing it.
