STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT declaring women eligible to certain school
offices.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall be ineligible to the
2 office of supervisor of schools or of superintending
3 school committee, on account of sex.

SECT. 2. This act shall be in effect when
2 approved by the governor.
