## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and thirtyfive of the laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, relating to the report of the secretary of the board of agriculture.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four of chapter two hundred and thirty-

- 2 five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
- 3 eighty, is hereby amended by striking out the
- 4 words "two hundred pages" and inserting therein
- 5 the words four hundred, so that said section as
- 6 amended, shall read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 4. The board shall appoint a secretary as
- 8 its chief executive officer for a term of three years
- 9 and until his successor shall be appointed, and may
- 10 prescribe his duties, a part of which shall be to

11 acquaint himself, by personal observation, investi-12 gation, and correspondence, with the methods and 13 wants of practical husbandry, the means of fertil-14 ization, the adaptation of various products to the 15 soils and climate of Maine; also with the progress 16 of scientific and practical agriculture elsewhere, 17 with a view to the more complete development of 18 the natural resources of the state. He shall 19 annually, on or before the third Wednesday in 20 January, present to the governor and council a 21 report of the doings of the board and the results 22 of his own labors and investigations, together with 23 such communications, suggestions and recom-24 mendations as may be useful. Ten thousand copies 25 of said report, in size not exceeding four hundred 26 pages, shall be printed; nine thousand bound in 27 paper covers, one thousand in cloth; one-half of 28 those in paper covers for the use of the legislature, 29 and the remainder, after reserving a suitable num-30 ber for foreign exchanges, for distribution under 31 the direction of the board, among the agricultural 32 associations and the people of the state.
