STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to civil actions in behalf of the state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

In addition to the remedies now provided by law,
2 any action in behalf of the state to enforce the col-
3 lection of any state taxes upon any corporation, or
4 to recover of any person or corporation any monies
5 due the state, public funds or property belonging
6 to the state, or the value thereof, may be brought in
7 any county within the state; *provided, however,* on
8 motion of the defendant, any judge of the supreme
9 judicial court for the state, holding the term at
10 which any such action is returnable, may upon
11 upon good and sufficient reasons shown, remove
12 the same to the docket of said court in any other
13 county in the state for trial, and may award costs
14 to the defendant for one term, upon such removal.
