STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT regulating the weight of salt.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The standard weight of a bushel of
2 Turks Island, or other coarse grades of salt, shall
3 be seventy pounds; the standard weight of a bushel
4 of Liverpool, or other fine grades of salt, shall be
5 sixty pounds; and the measure of salt shall be
6 determined as aforesaid, at the request of the ven-
7 dor or vendee, and if either party refuses so to do,
8 he shall forfeit twenty cents for each bushel, to the
9 person prosecuting therefor within thirty days.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
