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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-ONE.

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AN ACT establishing the salary of the clerk of the  
judicial courts for the county of York.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the judicial  
2 courts for the county of York shall hereafter be thir-  
3 teen hundred and fifty dollars per annum, and shall be  
4 payable by the county treasurer in quarterly pay-  
5 ments. Said sum shall be in full compensation for  
6 the performance of all duties required of him by  
7 law, including those performed by him as clerk of  
8 the county commissioners. He shall render an  
9 account of all fees of office as required by law; be  
10 responsible for the same, whether received or not,

11 and pay the whole amount to the treasurer of the  
12 county for the use thereof.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
2 with this act are hereby repealed.
