## STATE OF MAINE.

---

RESOLVE providing for the compilation, printing and distribution of the laws of this state, relating to public schools.

---

*Resolved,* That the superintendent of common schools be, and hereby is instructed and empowered to cause the laws of this state relating to common schools, to include the laws passed the present session relating to the same to be compiled, and seven thousand copies thereof printed, the whole cost not to exceed six hundred dollars; that he shall distribute the same so that every city, town and plantation, and every school district in the state, shall be put in possession of one copy thereof, which shall be held in custody as public property by the several clerks of the said cities, towns, plantations, and school districts, and by said clerks shall be transferred to their successors in office.
