IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to practice in the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The affidavit required by rule VI. of the supreme

- 2 court, to pleas or motions in abatement, may be
- 3 made at any time before the entry of the action,
- 4 or before filing the same, as provided by the rule
- 5 aforesaid.
