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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-ONE.

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AN ACT relating to levy of execution on real estate.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Real estate attachable, including  
2 the right to cut timber and grass, as described in  
3 chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes, may be  
4 taken on execution and sold, in the same manner  
5 as rights of redeeming real estate mortgaged, are  
6 taken on execution and sold; and the debtor shall  
7 have the same right of redemption from such sale.

SECT. 2. Such seizure and sale, if made accord-  
2 ing to law, shall pass to the purchaser at such sale,  
3 all the right, title or interest the execution debtor  
4 has in such real estate at the time of such seizure,

5 or had at the time of the attachment thereof on  
6 the original writ, subject to the debtor's right of  
7 redemption as provided by law.
