STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to levy of execution on real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Real estate attachable, including
- 2 the right to cut timber and grass, as described in
- 3 chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes, may be
- 4 taken on execution and sold, in the same manner
- 5 as rights of redeeming real estate mortgaged, are
- 6 taken on execution and sold; and the debtor shall
- 7 have the same right of redemption from such sale.
 - SECT. 2. Such seizure and sale, if made accord-
- 2 ing to law, shall pass to the purchaser at such sale,
- 3 all the right, title or interest the execution debtor
- 4 has in such real estate at the time of such seizure,

5 or had at the time of the attachment thereof on6 the original writ, subject to the debtor's right of7 redemption as provided by law.
