STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section six, chapter fifty-seven of
the revised statutes, relating to mills and their
repairs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section six, chapter fifty-seven of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended, by striking out the
3 words "except buckwheat and Indian wheat," in
4 the second line of said section, and also all of said
5 section after the words "thereof," so that said sec-
6 tion as amended shall read as follows:

7 *Sect. 6.* The toll for grinding, cleansing and
8 bolting all kinds of grain shall not exceed one six-
9 tenth part thereof.
